

Pupil Premium Statement 2016

The Headteacher and teachers decide how to utilise the Pupil Premium allocation, as they are best placed to assess what additional provision should be made for individual pupils.

Pupil Premium was paid at a rate of £935 per child or £1900 per looked after child during the period April 2015 to March 2016.

The Pupil Premium for Knightsfield School for 2015-2016 was £7,510.00. 17.9% of pupils received free school meals in 2015-2016 or in one or more of the previous 6 years. Funding was spent on 1 to 1 support for reading, numeracy, spelling and vocabulary. Additional speech & language therapy, in class Teaching Assistant support, behaviour support and extra curricular activities and visits were also provided. 100% of pupils receiving Pupil Premium made progress in Maths and English in 2015-2016. Pupils receiving Pupil Premium funding made similar progress to other pupils in the school.

The Pupil Premium for 2016-2017 will be £6,575.00. 15.4% of pupils are receiving the Pupil premium for 2016-2017. Funding will be spent on individual support and resources for literacy and numeracy, ICT equipment and sports activities. These interventions will be monitored during the year and if necessary adjusted according to the progress pupils are making.
